

**Q. Where will the temporary school be located while the new Verde Elementary is being built?**

A. Verde students will temporarily be housed on land which is south of the Don Estridge Middle School Campus, east of Military Trail. Our main entrance will be on Banyan Blvd.

**Q. When will Verde students be moving to the holding campus?**

A. Verde students are scheduled to begin classes at the temporary holding site effective Monday, August 12, 2019.

**Q. Will the temporary campus be a safe environment for students and families?**

A. The district's School Police Department is actively involved in the planning of the holding school. High resolution cameras, gates for all entrances, and perimeter fencing are being installed based on Police recommendations. A full-time Police officer will also be stationed at the holding site.

**Q. Will there be covered areas for students, staff, and families to walk throughout the campus?**

A. Covered walkways are planned for all main walkways throughout campus.

**Q. How will morning and afternoon traffic be managed?**

A. The elementary school start time is 90 minutes before the middle school start time, so the circulation of Verde parent/staff and bus traffic should be cleared out before the Don Estridge start-up begins. The same would be held for the afternoon, where there is a 2-hour gap between elementary and middle school release.

**Q. Will students still have Physical Education and recess outside?**

A. Space will be dedicated for students to have an outside area to play and for students to have a place to participate in Physical Education classes.

**Q. Will my child receive district provided transportation to and from the temporary school school?**

A. All Verde students will qualify for bussing to and from the temporary holding site. It is highly recommended that parents use district provided bus transportation!

**Q. When will bus routes be available for Verde students and families choosing to utilize district provided transportation in 2019-2020?**

A. The District's Transportation Department has already provided us with pick-up and drop off schedules for 2019-2020. **Specific Bus Route Numbers** will be available towards the end of July/beginning of August.

**Q. Where will the children eat breakfast and lunch?**

A. Verde students will eat breakfast and lunch in large modular buildings located on the temporary campus. Seating capacity will be greater than it is now at our current campus.

**Q. How long is it expected that Verde students will be at the temporary holding school?**

A. It is expected that Verde students and staff will only remain at the temporary holding site for 1 school year. Beginning in August 2020, we plan to move into our new school on Verde Trail. Plans are already created, and architectural pictures can be viewed, in our main office for the newly constructed campus.

**Q. Will Verde be able to continue offering the outstanding educational environment for students and the community while at the holding site?**

A. The strength of any school lies within its' teachers! Our staff is committed, and will be ready to provide, world-class instruction when we welcome students to our temporary holding site in August 2019.
